Firstly, thank you for enrolling your child at Young Masters Visual Arts School.

At Young Masters we aim to deliver high quality arts education in small classes of mixed ages, backgrounds and abilities. To do this we ensure that each class has a minimum of two staff with relevant expertise, and we provide top quality equipment as a part of your fee. Staff hold DBS certificates, and are aware of all our policies and procedures, including child protection, equal opportunities, health and safety and data protection. All students follow our Code of Behaviour, which can be found on the Young Masters website. The focus of this document is about respect and understanding. We pride ourselves on the community of young artists that we have nurtured, and our lessons develop social skills and imaginative capacity as well as creative skills.

To preserve continuity of the children's artistic education we encourage children to attend the same class, every week. Where parents/carers are not able to bring their children to their respective class, we will accommodate them in one of the other time slots available within the same week, but as each teacher adapts the curriculum from a core document, this may not allow for the best outcomes and progress to be made.

Please attend classes on time, late arrivals may miss important demonstrations and hold up their classmates.

Photography of students will take place and will be used for school publicity and social media unless there is an objection from the parent/carer.

The children cannot leave school premises without the tutor's agreement. We will need to know who is collecting your child/children after the class.

Young Masters carries Public Liability for outdoor visits and indoor equipment.

No responsibility can be taken for personal belongings.

All children should wear suitable, old clothing when attending their class and be aware that they may get paint/other materials onto these clothes.
